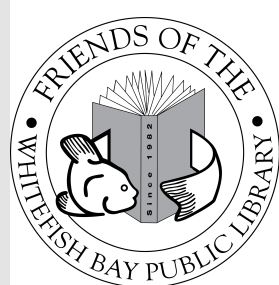
Celebrate Library Lovers' Month
