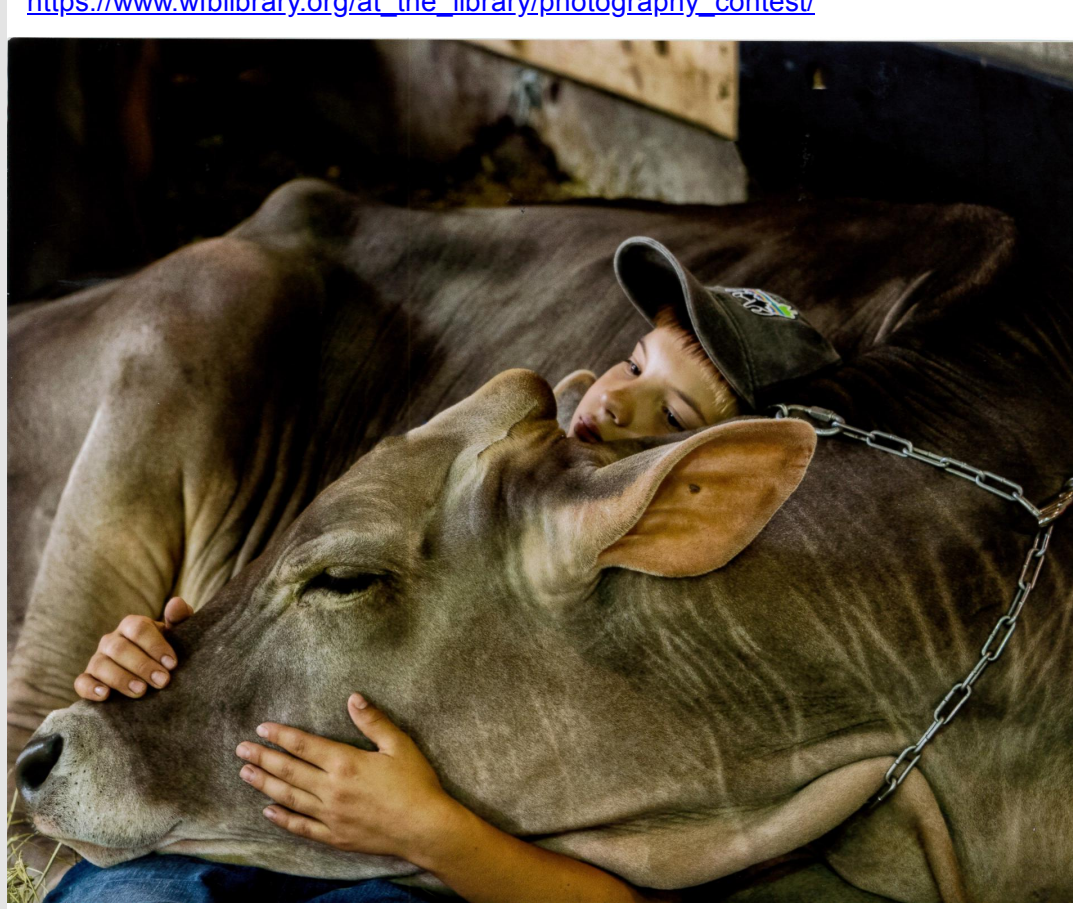
Dr. Lorrie Wenzel is a Professor of Scripture, former college faculty member, church historian and noted expert in biblical imagery in great cathedrals
