DAILY LITERACY FUN FOR YOU AND YOUR LITTLE ONE!

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1 TALK

Ask your child how many words they can think of that have the same beginning sounds as "November."

2 SCIENCE

Make popcorn together! Talk about what makes the kernels pop.

3 WRITE

Send your child on a quest to find all the circle shaped objects in your home. Then have them trace the circles on paper!

4 VISIT THE LIBRARY!

5 READ

Read a book together! Once you're finished, ask your child to retell the story in their own words.

6 PLAY

Create puppets out of things you find around the house like paper bags, socks, or spoons! Act out a favorite story.

7 COUNT

Go around the house with your child and have them count all of the squares they see.

8 SING

Sing "BINGO" while doing chores around the house.

9 READ

At breakfast time, read the back of a cereal box or packaging together.

10 SCIENCE

Fill a clear container with small metal objects such as bobby pins, paper clips, and bolts. Let your child use a magnet to lift the objects!

11 COUNT

Ask your child how many doors are in your home. Then go count them together!

12 WRITE

After reading a book together, have your child draw a picture of a character from the book!

13 READ

Looking for rhyming words as you read through a book.

14 PLAY

Hold a birthday party for one of your child's stuffed animals! You can decorate, play games, and serve snacks!

15 TALK

As you drive in the car, talk about the different sounds you hear.

16 SING

Sing as you make breakfast together!

17 PLAY

Find items around your house to use as musical instruments and start a band!

18 VISIT THE LIBRARY!

19 COUNT

Scoop out some cereal or other snack and ask your child to guess how many pieces there are-- then count them!

20 WRITE

Have your child practice writing their name using different colors.

21 SING

Make up a song about a turkey and sing it to a familiar tune!

22 SCIENCE

Have your child help you sort the trash from the recyclables today!

23 COUNT

Have your child trace their hand to make a turkey. After they color it, help them count how many feathers the turkey has!

24 READ

Find a book about turkeys or Thanksgiving to read together. We love ['Twas the Night Before Thanksgiving](#) by Dav Pilkey!

25 WRITE

Have your child write up a menu for your Thanksgiving meal!

26 TALK

Happy Thanksgiving! Talk about all the things you are thankful for.

27 PLAY

Play a game of "I Spy" around the house with your child.

28 SING

Sing a favorite song in an opera voice!

29 READ

Choose a subject your child is interested in and then go to the library to pick out a nonfiction book to read together.

30 PLAY

Have your child pretend they are a veterinarian and give their pet (real or stuffed!) an imaginary checkup!
