Friends of the Whitefish Bay Public Library 2022 Annual Report

Our mission Statement is: to provide appropriate and sufficient financial and volunteer resources in support of the Whitefish Bay Public Library's mission.

To help accomplish our mission the Board held 10 regular meetings in 2022. We also had some fun socializing at Schoolhouse Park in August. We brought our own lunches and enjoyed the beautiful afternoon. A Brewer outing was also held in August.

The Friends awarded two \$500 scholarships to Whitefish Bay High School Seniors. They were judged by an essay about how the library has influenced their lives. We received 12 entries. The essays were published in the Fall *PageTurner* along with the students' pictures, college choices and areas of study.

Friends held two book sales and they were very popular, as usual.

The Friends were able to allocate an unusually high \$78,450 to the library. With these funds the library continued their regular programs and projects for children, teens, and adults. This allocation also included a donation of \$15,000 to the formation of the library's Foundation, \$20,000 for a new self-checkout station, \$6,000 for a teen area refresh, \$5,000 for the library's 85th anniversary celebration and \$5,000 for a soundproof booth.

Our expenses are well under control. We compare ourselves to other 501(c) (3) organizations and our expenses are very low.
