# Friends of the Whitefish Bay Public Library 2023 Annual Report

To help accomplish our mission the Board held 11 regular meetings in 2023. We also had some fun socializing at Schoolhouse Park in August. We brought our own lunches and enjoyed the beautiful afternoon. A Brewer outing was also held in August.

The Friends awarded two \$1,000 scholarships to Whitefish Bay High School Seniors. They were judged by an essay about how the library has influenced their lives. We received 11 entries.

Friends held two book sales and they were very popular, as usual.
